

Health and Safety Policy Statement

Workers are responsible to wear all PPE, follow established safety policies, and report to his supervisor any defect in equipment/safety device and the existence of any known hazards. A worker shall never operate a piece of equipment or perform a task for which he has not been properly trained.

All sub-contractors and suppliers will be responsible and accountable for their health and safety performances. In relation to these efforts, Alfred Beam Excavating Ltd. will also coordinate with customers' workplace policies to ensure our policy standard can be met or exceeded.

Any hazards or incidents of health and safety matters associated with the work of employees will be openly communicated and discussed.

The company will monitor its safety performance and strive to continuously improve in that regard. Its health and safety program will reflect this unyielding commitment to safety.
